## Information regarding Feedback Fridays - Remote learning

Following the success of a trial last week we will now be offering 'Feedback Fridays' each week for our Year One to Six children.

Taking on board feedback from our survey, we would like to give pupils the opportunity for the following each Friday morning:

- A chance to catch up on any work/tasks that need finishing
- An opportunity for pupils to respond to any feedback they may not have had time to act upon.
- An opportunity to drop in via zoom to speak with the class teacher at any point each Friday morning.

Once the 'live welcome' has finished, teachers will start a zoom drop in session which will run throughout the morning. Pupils are invited to log in to Zoom and drop-in at any point throughout the morning, if they wish to do so. Your child will then wait in the waiting room and will be admitted once there is a space.

Once pupils have clicked the Zoom link, they will be admitted on a 1-1 basis to catch-up regarding any work they wish to discuss from the week, access further support with work, have a well-being chat or receive advice on managing their Seesaw workload.

Once pupils have caught up on tasks, they can use the rest of the morning to practise comprehension on Read Theory, spend time on TT Rock stars, or enjoy reading their scheme or choice book. We also encourage pupils to continue with their exercise and morning break.

We're keen to find a good balance for the children in their learning and their well-being. This opportunity will give them the support needed and time to manage their week. We appreciate that we have busy timetables and we want to give our pupils quality time to complete the activities to the best of their abilities.
